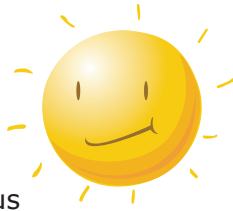


Camp Centerland is for kids entering K-10th grades and is open to all families.

Friday Shabbat Celebrations and ongoing, fun Jewish Cultural learning.

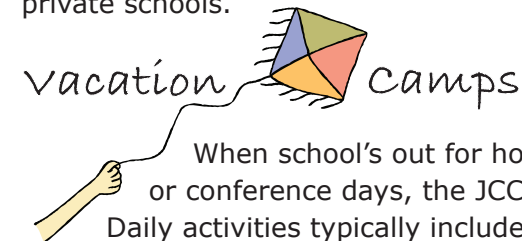
Additional Enrichment

Transportation



Kids Place offers supervised, chartered transportation if school district bus service is not available. The Getzville program follows the Williamsville Central School District and the downtown program follows the Buffalo Public School District. Both programs also service additional area public, charter and private schools.
